

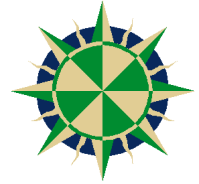

Parents may pick up their child early if they choose to.

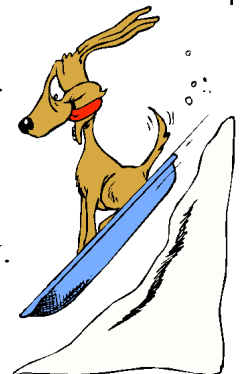
Be sure to "sign out" your student in the school office if they leave early.
