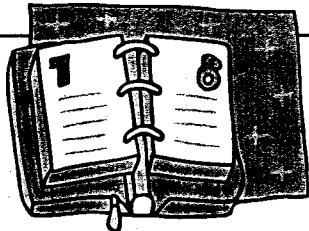
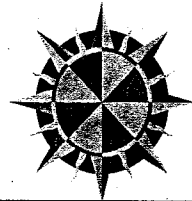

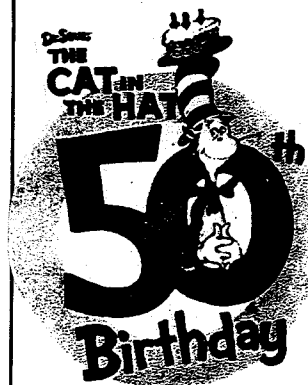

We may NOT be having our ski trip due to a lack of interest. You will be notified on Monday morning the final total of sign ups. (We need a minimum of 30 registered and paid).

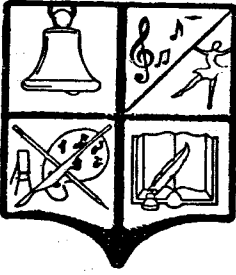

The snow hill has had some parents help would like to see more parent volunteers.


Next meeting will discuss more fund raising ideas. Including another pizza fundraiser and flower bulb fundraiser.
