DROP-OFF & PICK UP

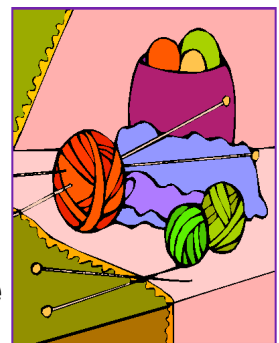

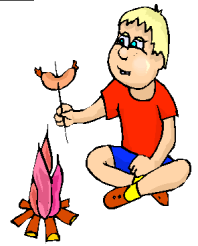
