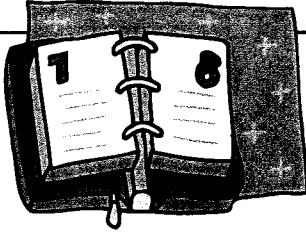

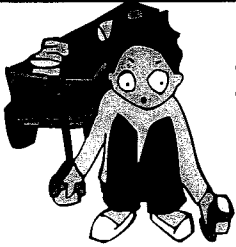
5th Place - Regional Spelling Bee held last Saturday in Traverse City. We are extremely proud of his incredible accomplishment.

How Many Shamrocks Can You Find?





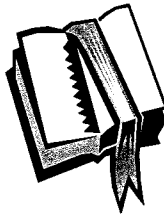
## RUMMAGE SALE COMING SOON

The snow hill has had some parents help would like to see more parent volunteers.


Next meeting will discuss more fund raising ideas. Including another pizza fundraiser and flower bulb fundraiser.
