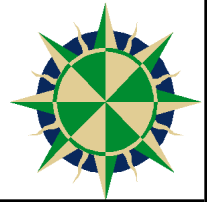

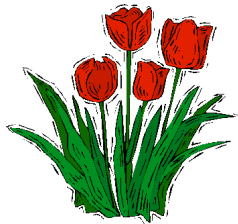

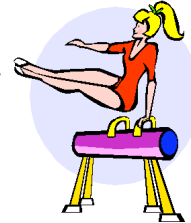

## **C.A.B. ENROLLMENT**



I don't know about you but it's hard for me to believe that we are about to enter the last marking period for this school year.

Each year seems to pass faster than the last. At our school board meeting on Monday, we established a time line for preparing our operating budget for 2007-2008 school year.

The most important piece of information is the number of children who will be attending Concord Academy Boyne next year. That's why accurate enrollment figures are vital in creating a fiscally responsible budget.

What can you do to help us in the process? First you can make your decision concerning next year as soon as possible so we can proceed accordingly with our budgeting; and second you can spread the good news about Concord Academy - Boyne. Word of mouth is not only the least expensive form of advertising, it's the **most effective**. A satisfied customer can't wait to share the positive experience with others and I hope we can count on you to do the same. In addition to major

events like Kindergarten Round-Up (4/24) and our Open House (4/26), you can encourage your friends and neighbors to come and visit the school and see for themselves what we're all about here.

I don't have to tell you what difficult times it is for all schools in Michigan. With an enormous deficit in the State budget, schools are facing an uncertain future in the amount of their state funding. The best way to off set increased expenses, as well as off setting projected short falls, is to have our classes full. A limited class size safeguards a favorable teacher/student ratio; but an undersized class (less the 16 students), jeopardizes the school's ability to keep pace, to help us grow, and plan intelligently.
